Novice DMT – 2 passes (no finals). 1 front DISMOUNT s/s will be allowed per pass, No barani, no spotter s/s, no back s/s

Competitors under 9 years of age – may compete Age division, but cannot qualify for Nationals

Disciplines: Individual Trampoline and Double Mini only (no Synchro)

Equipment: 1 Ross and 1 Eurotramp mat trampoline, 1 Eurotramp Double Mini.
